The ITT will also be made available through the Infrastructure Trust Fund (ITF) Portal (www.eu-africa-infrastructure-tf.net) and the Lux-Development (Lux-Dev) Portal (<http://www.lux-development.lu>) to potential tenderers in EU Member States as well as in the Africa, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States.

Your attention is drawn to the following:

1. The Agency has earmarked for this activity a budget of **1,000,000 EUR**.

This Invitation to Tender is open to economic operators from the all ESA Member States and Canada as well as potential tenderers in EU Member States as well as in the Africa, Caribbean and Pacific Group of States. A complete list of all eligible countries is attached as Annex 1 hereto.

2. It should be noted that the total duration of this activity should not exceed 12 months.
3. The Member States of ESA have made it mandatory for the Agency to register economic entities wishing to do business with ESA. Tenderers are requested to state in their proposal the full address and the ESA Bidder Code of the Prime and each proposed subcontractor.

Economic entities wishing to do business with ESA that are not yet registered as potential tenderer, are requested to complete the online questionnaire on the ESA EMITS website (<http://emits.esa.int/>) under “Entity registration”. Further information on the registration process can be found at the INDUSTRY OUTLOOK pages available via: <http://www.esa.int/home-ind/>. As of the completion of the questionnaire in INDUSTRY OUTLOOK registered economic entities will have to update the questionnaire on an annual basis. Failure to do so may result in EMITS access being blocked.

However, due to the expected involvement of potential tenderers from non-ESA Member States, proposals will exceptionally also be accepted for evaluation without an ESA Bidder Code for economic operators from non-ESA Member States. Award of a resulting contract is subject to the full registration of the selected Prime and its proposed subcontractor(s).

4. Tenderers are requested to complete and return the Acknowledgement of Receipt attached as Annex 2 to Appendix 3. Please note it is also requested that the Prime notifies to the Agency its intention to bid for this activity via the EMITS Expression of Interest function. This will enable the Agency to register the relevant bid response at the Tender Opening. You are also reminded that the bidder may select 'Public' visibility or 'ESA only' when expressing interest.

Please note the provisions of the Dispatch and Receipt Conditions contained in the General Conditions of Tender, in particular those relating to the non-admissibility of offers arriving after expiry of the closing date.
